Effective Faith-Sharing

- Effective faith-sharing isn't about having all the right words; it's about how we live, speak, and treat others in everyday moments.
- People notice our actions long before they hear our words.
- Galatians 5:22–23 (NLT); Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV)

I. Let Your Life Be Your Sermon

- Your actions often preach louder than your words.
- Everyday kindness, patience, and honesty reflect Jesus more than arguments ever could.
- 2 Corinthians 3:2 (KJV); James 2:14–17 (NLT)

II. Use Failures as a Witness

- We are human, but God's grace works through our weakness.
- Be honest, apologize, and let Jesus shine through flaws.
- Your humility can point people to Christ more than perfection ever could.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 (KJV); 1 Timothy 1:16 (NIV)

III. Be Spirit-Led, Not Scripted

- Don't force conversations—pray for Spirit-led opportunities.
- Your quiet obedience and small acts of love can change someone's eternity.
- Ephesians 4:1–2, 4 (NLT); Luke 12:12 (KJV)

- Sharing faith is about living Spirit-filled lives. Every word, action, and response can be used by God. Someone's life may be changed forever—not by a sermon, but by your love and example.

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- The foundation of Spirit-filled living is the Fruit of the Spirit.
- **Galatians 5:22–26 (NLT)**
“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.”
- Everyday moments are where faith and witnessing become real
 - **Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV)**
“Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.”

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 - Galatians 5:22–23 (NLT); Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV)

● **Let Your Life Be Your Sermon**

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- Your life is a letter that everyone will read. Will it tell others of Jesus?
 - **2 Corinthians 3:2(KJV)** “
Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men”
- If we have all of the faith and love in the world but never show it, then what good does it do?
 - **James 2:14-17(NLT)**
What good is it, dear brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but don't show it by your actions? Can that kind of faith save anyone? Suppose you see a brother or sister who has no food or clothing, and you say, "Good-bye and have a good day; stay warm and eat well"—but then you don't give that person any food or clothing. What good does that do? So you see, faith by itself isn't enough. Unless it produces good deeds, it is dead and useless.

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● Use Failures as a Witness

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- One of the best ways to witness is by being REAL with people and letting them know that they are not alone in the struggle.
 - **2 Corinthians 12:9 (KJV)**
“And he said unto me: My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in your weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.”
- Temporary embarrassment is nothing compared to the eternal responsibility of a soul.
 - **1 Timothy 1:16 NIV**
“But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his immense patience as an example for those who would believe in him and receive eternal life.”

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- You don't need to force a conversation; but pray for divine appointments. Sensitivity to the Spirit will always open doors you didn't expect.
 - **Ephesians 4:1-2, 4 (NLT)**
"Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future."
- When we let the Holy Spirit guide us, He turns ordinary conversations and actions into eternal opportunities.
 - **Luke 12:12 (KJV)**
"For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say."

Someone's life may be forever changed, not by a sermon you preach, but by the way you love, forgive, and live.

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
