


How to Comfort Others Who are Going Through Trials and Find Strength and Support within Christian Community





PRAY


This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, And saved him out of all his troubles.

COMMIT


Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.







We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;


II Corinthians 4:8-9
